Greetings and Approval of Minutes

Secretary Rona Kramer welcomed members. Roll call was taken and there were enough members present for a quorum. The April 14, 2021, and June 23, 2021 meeting minutes were approved.

Updates from the Department of Aging

MDoA, in conjunction with the Department of Health, has been publishing a weekly report on Nursing Home Facilities noting the status of vaccination of the staff and residents.

Stacy Howes, Ph.D., Chief, Long Term Care and Health Plan Quality Initiatives, Center for Quality Measurement and Reporting, MHCC, gave a presentation on the Nursing Home Family Experience of Care Survey.

Updates from Subcommittee

Eric Colchamiro gave the update. The Subcommittee met on July 22, 2021, and discussed how to focus on the work of the Full Committee at the start of the pandemic and moving forward. The subcommittee agreed to meet in the Fall to focus on the annual report to present to the Full Committee for its consideration. We also agreed on one additional meeting in late January of each year to hear a presentation from the Department of Legislative Services staff assigned to the Committee about legislation related to nursing homes and assisted living facilities to recommend a position to the Full Committee regarding that legislation. The subcommittee meeting for 2022 has been scheduled for January 20, 2022 at 3:00 PM.

Eric Colchamiro made a motion to the Full Committee to add two brief additional meetings to the current calendar of Full Committee meetings. They could be chaired by Secretary Kramer or her designee. The first meeting would be on or around December 2, 2021, with the intent to vote on and approve an annual report for the Full Committee after the Subcommittees meeting in late November 2021. This would enable the report to include Dr. Nay's annual report from the Office of Health Care Quality. The second meeting would be on or the week of, January 24, 2022. The intent of this meeting, if necessary, would be to review and/or determine the position of the subcommittee's recommendation on legislation. Lorrie Van Akkeren seconded this motion.

Senator Beidle stated the legislative representatives will be back in session in January 2022 and suggested the meeting date be held around session committee meeting and, also notated that bills may still be coming in. Senator Eckardt suggested later in the afternoon may work or that Monday and that Department of Legislative Services may be very busy. The motion was approved.

Secretary Kramer stated we will be needing to draft the report and asked anyone interested in working on the draft, to please an email to Alexandra Baldi.
