Elder SAFE

Goals

- Provide supportive services to older adults experiencing or in danger of experiencing elder abuse
- Increase awareness of elder abuse and the signs and symptoms of abuse among older adults, caregivers, and their family members
- Increase understanding of elder abuse and mandated reporting among relevant professionals

Performance Measures

- Number of unduplicated older adults, caregivers, and community members receiving supportive services
- Number of unduplicated older adults, caregivers, and community members receiving education about elder abuse
- Number of workshops or educational opportunities provided to older adults, caregivers, and other community members
- Number of unduplicated professionals receiving guidance on elder abuse and/or mandated reporting through training and outreach efforts
- Number of workshops or educational opportunities provided to professionals

Holocaust Survivor Services

Goals

 Provide supportive services to Holocaust survivors that enable them to age in place

- Ensure Holocaust survivors receive culturally competent, person-centered, trauma-informed care
- Train professionals in trauma-informed and person-centered practices specific to Holocaust survivors

Performance Measures

- Number of unduplicated Holocaust survivors who received supportive services that enable them to age in place
- Percentage of Holocaust survivors served who remain in the home
- Number of unduplicated professionals trained in person-centered, trauma-informed care
- Number of unduplicated professionals providing person-centered, trauma-informed care

Traditional NORC/ aging in place concept

Goals

- Provide services to older adults and caregivers that support aging in place and decrease isolation and loneliness
- Plan and deliver services in cooperation with community members and volunteers
- Performance Measures
- Number of unduplicated older adults receiving services that support aging in place and/or decreasing isolation
- Percentage of participants reporting that services improved quality of life and/ or social connectedness
- Number of activities provided to older adults that support aging in place and social connectedness, or decreased isolation
- Number of unduplicated service recipients, community members, and volunteers involved in the planning and delivery of services
